Duties & Responsibilities

Key Areas of Responsibilities will include the following but not be limited to:

- Assemble and maintain electrical or electronic wiring, equipment, appliances, apparatus, and fixtures, using hand tools and power tools.
- Diagnose malfunctioning systems, apparatus, and components, using test equipment and hand tools, to locate the cause of a breakdown and correct the problem.
- Connect wires to circuit breakers, transformers, or other components.
- Inspect electrical systems, equipment, and components to identify hazards, defects, and the need for adjustment or repair, and to ensure compliance with codes.
- Advise management on whether continued operation of equipment could be hazardous.
- Assist in testing of electrical systems and continuity of circuits in electrical wiring, equipment, and fixtures, using testing devices such as ohmmeters, voltmeters, and oscilloscopes, to ensure compatibility and safety of system.
- Assisting with the maintenance of the buildings, plant and refrigeration of the premises.
- Ensuring and maintaining a safe work environment and adhering to health and safety requirements.
- Assisting with all repairs, breakdowns, projects and daily tasks and carrying out of all the activities on the maintenance schedule.
